REFORESTATION PROJECT UPDATE / NEXT MEETING

As a follow up to the May 31st meeting, Tom Hamilton spoke with Tim Swagler, Frank Fulreader and the Town.

Tim gave us a quote of \$1,500 to remove certain trees and to shape the two willows so that they will continue to provide a noise and light barrier. Frank gave us a quote of \$11,825 for a variety of new trees and shrubs and the Town agreed to provide the fill necessary to create a peninsula out into the pond, to dredge the pond, to move the fill creating a berm and to seed the berm and any damaged lawn areas.

On Thursday, June 29th at 7pm, a meeting will be held at Tom Hamilton's house to discuss how the neighborhood should move forward with this proposed project. All are welcome to attend.
