

**Forest Hills Neighborhood Association
Executive Committee Meeting**

Tuesday, April 9, 2007

A special meeting of the Executive Committee of the Forest Hills Neighborhood Association was called to order at Tom Quinn's house at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 9, 2007.

In attendance were: Tom Quinn, Karin Kacprzyński, Linda & Ed Dunn, Alex Neubert, Chuck Sorce and Jay Sackett.

Tom Quinn called the meeting to order to discuss the 3 proposals that were received in response to a bid request that was circulated. After a discussion of the bids received, the services expected to be performed, the Executive Committee voted to accept the bid of Evergreen Landscape. This bid is roughly \$1000.00 less than last years contract. The Evergreen Landscape Company is a large firm that has been in business for many years in the Rochester area. The Executive Committee also agreed that a preliminary walk-around needs to be done so that there is a clear understanding about the work expected to be completed.

Tom Quinn then advised the group that he has been in contact with Tom Beck regarding cleaning of the streets and that sweepers should come by in the next 2 or 3 weeks. The Town is still anticipating performing the roadwork during either June or July. The Town has also advised Tom that the dredging of the Lake Crescent pond may get pushed until after summer.
