

**Forest Hills Neighborhood Association  
Executive Committee Meeting**

**Tuesday, June 3, 2008**

A special meeting of the Executive Committee of the Forest Hills Neighborhood Association was called to order at Tom Quinn's house at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, June 3, 2008.

Present were Tom Quinn (President), Linda & Ed Dunn (Treasurer) and Alex Neubert (Secretary).

Chuck Sorce was also present.

Tom Quinn called the meeting to order. The first item of discussion was to announce that Wendy and Kurt McLaughlin were relocating and that Wendy would no longer be serving as Street Rep for Lake Crescent. The group briefly discussed finding a replacement.

The next item of discussion was a review of Waste Management fees from last year (approximately \$210 per household), and how the Association determined it's budget for 2008/2009 based on household participation and a prior understanding with Waste Management (which was subsequently presented at the Annual Meeting) and how Waste Management has now recently contacted to the Association and has indicated that our fee will be increased as a result of the increase in fuel prices. The Association had budgeted approximately \$17,000 for 2008/2009. Waste Management has advised us that our aggregate fee will be at \$19,715 (an approximate increase of \$50 per household per year). As such, it was agreed that it would be in the Association's best interest to approach other trash collection companies to see what they would charge us.

The next item of discussion was a review of our fee arrangement with Frank Fulreader for the purchase of trees to plant along Fairport Road in Lake Crescent Park and how his fee has also increased significantly due to fuel increases. Tom expressed his frustration. Again, it was agreed that it would be in the best interest of the neighborhood to shop around and see whether we can get a better price.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 p.m.

It was noted that another special meeting may need to be called prior to the next regular meeting of the Executive Committee which is scheduled for July 10, 2008.
