

**Forest Hills Neighborhood Association
Executive Committee Meeting**

Thursday, November 13, 2008

A meeting of the Executive Committee of the Forest Hills Neighborhood Association was called to order at Tom Quinn's house at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, November 13, 2008.

Present were Tom Quinn (President) and Alex Neubert (Secretary). Also in attendance were the following street representatives: Ken Dodgson and Jay Sackett. Neighbor Tom Hamilton was also present.

Tom Quinn called the meeting to order. As there was not a quorum present, it was decided that the minutes from the September 11th meeting, along with the financial report and the 2009 Calendar of Events, would be circulated by email and voted on accordingly. The minutes, financial report and calendar of events were properly emailed to each member of the Executive Committee for review and each were approved unanimously.

With no quorum present, no further business could be attended to.

Tom mentioned that he had been contacted by Jim Unckless of the Perinton Historical Society to see whether the neighbors would consider an open house tour to take place in late April 2009. The group briefly discussed the pros and cons of such a tour and its impact upon the neighborhood. Ken mentioned that the Landmark Society conducts a much more organized tour and that there would be a certain prestige associated with it as opposed to the Perinton Historical Society.

The next item for discussion was the existing vacancies on the Executive Committee, namely the Vice President's position and the Street Rep for Lake Crescent. The group discussed the importance of a street rep for Lake Crescent so as to ensure that the residents are properly represented and to ensure that they continue to receive flyers, newsletters, etc. from the Executive Committee.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
